Attached are questions about the topics in the summer פְּרָשְׁיּוֹת. Students who find and write the answers for at least six פְּרָשְׁיּוֹת will earn a prize when we return to school in September. You may ask for help from other people, but please do not use another student's answers.

You may use a Hebrew/English Chumash with Rashi to find the answers in the pesukim noted at the end of each question.

Parshat Beha'alotcha

1. Which two items in this parsha are "banged out of one solid piece of metal"? What other component of the Mishkan is made of one solid piece of metal?
2. In which two places in this parsha does fire appear?
3. Which letter appears in this parsha that is not part of a word?
4. In what context are five vegetables mentioned in the same verse?
5. Which two people appear in the parsha, but nowhere else in the Bible (Tanach)?

Parshat Shelach

1. Which name of one of Yaakov's sons appears in the name of one of the spies?
2. Who in this parsha does Hashem call "my servant"? Who else in the Torah does Hashem call "my servant"?
3. In this parsha, which three fruits of Israel's special seven species all appear in one verse?
4. Where does the number 10 appear in this parsha?
5. In this parsha, which two people tear their clothing? When is the first time in the Torah that a group of people (not an individual) tear their clothing?

Parshat Korach

1. Besides parshas Korach, which five other parshas are named after a person?
2. Aside from Moshe and Aharon, which two brothers are mentioned in this parsha?
3. In this parsha, which land is described as "flowing with milk and honey?"
4. Which non-kosher animal is mentioned in this parsha? Where is the first time in the Torah that this animal appears?
5. In this parsha, the earth opened its mouth and swallowed Korach and his followers (Numbers 16:32). Where does the Torah refer to the land spitting out people?
